Subject: Extension of validity of Sanitary Import Permit (SIP) due to COVID-19 lockdown – regarding.

In continuation of this Department's O.M. of even number, dated 20th April, 2020 (**copy enclosed**), considering the lockdown and limited national / international transportation during COVID 19, this Department extends the validity of such Sanitary Import Permits upto 30th June, 2020 which were/are expiring between 1st March, 2020 to 30th June, 2020.

2. However, for import of milk and milk products into India, the enclosed sanitary protocol will replace the sanitary protocol annexed with SIPs uploaded on the SIP Portal which were issued before the 20th December, 2019.
